What is Presumptive Eligibility (PE) for Pregnant Women?

Presumptive Eligibility (PE) allows pregnant women who have not yet applied for Medicaid to receive **temporary** prenatal care for up to 60 days while their eligibility benefits are determined.

How do I know if I'm Eligible for PE?

PE may be granted to a pregnant woman who:

- Is a Kentucky Resident;
- Meets income guidelines;
- Does not have a current pending Medicaid application on file with the Department for Community Based Services (DCBS);
- Is not enrolled currently in Medicaid;
- Has not been granted PE previously for the current pregnancy; and
- Is not an inmate of a public institution

What Prenatal Services does PE cover?

- Office visits
- Lab tests and X-rays (including ultrasounds)
- Medicine
- Dental
- Transportation to and from your healthcare provider's office (if you qualify)
- Emergency Room (when necessary)
