

Here is what you need to know about your renewal date!

Medicaid renewals happen every year. You will receive a communication from Kentucky Medicaid when it is your time to renew, but you can also find out when your renewal is coming at any time! Below is how to find the Renewal Date in Self-Service Portal, which is known as kynect:

1. Go to the Benefits Tab

2. The Medicaid Renewal Date is the last date of the Benefit Period. Note: This is the date Medicaid coverage will end if not renewed. Action may be required before this date to ensure there is no gap in coverage.

Or: If the Benefit Period End Date is "Ongoing" then the type of Medicaid this person receives does not require renewal.
