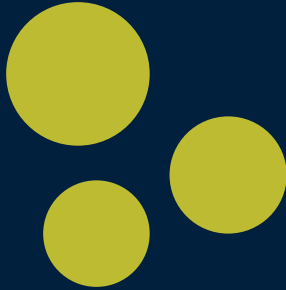
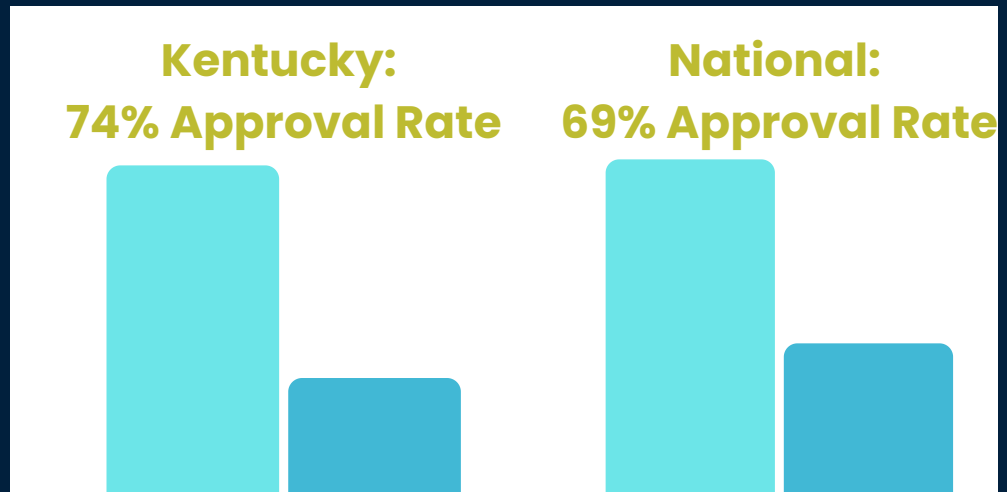


KENTUCKY PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY UNWINDING MEDICAID RENEWALS



Since May 2023 Kentucky has been tracking renewals as part of unwinding from the Public Health Emergency (PHE). The tracking focused on approvals and terminations, including how the renewal was processed. This data was compiled and compared to national rates provided by KFF's September 2024 Enrollment and Unwinding Tracker.

Team Kentucky was able to keep more Medicaid members covered than the national average. They had a higher overall approval rate and a lower termination rate for all renewals.



In Kentucky, 73% of all approvals were ex parte, higher than the national average of 61%.

Of those approvals, a higher portion of them were approved "ex parte." This means that Team Kentucky was able to automatically approve coverage by verifying information without the member having to take any action.

Of members that lost their coverage, there was also a lower portion of them that were procedurally terminated. This means that less people were terminated just because they never replied. Team Kentucky made specific efforts to keep this rate as low as possible.
