# What is happening?



If you became eligible for Medicare after
January 31, 2020 but did not enroll due to the public health emergency (PHE) and Medicaid coverage, you may have missed a Medicare enrollment period. Medicaid renewals are starting and you may lose coverage.

## What does this mean for me?



You will need to enroll in Medicare. There are new federal rules that create a Special Enrollment Period to allow you to enroll in Medicare outside of your Open Enrollment Period and the General Enrollment Period without a late penalty.

#### What can I do?



You can enroll in
Medicare through an
Special Enrollment
Period when you are
notified that your
Medicaid coverage is
ending.
