Medicare Special Enrollment Period for Patients

Understanding Options for Your Patients

What is happening?



If they became eligible for Medicare after January 31, 2020 but did not enroll due to the public health emergency (PHE) and having Medicaid coverage, they may have missed a Medicare enrollment period. Medicaid renewals are starting and they may lose coverage.

What does this mean for them?



They will need to enroll in Medicare. There are new federal rules that create a Special Enrollment Period to allow them to enroll in Medicare outside of your Open Enrollment Period and the General Enrollment Period without a late penalty.

What can they do?



They can enroll in
Medicare through a
Special Enrollment
Period when they are
notified that their
Medicaid coverage is
ending.
